ABOUT OUR WORK EXPERIENCE PROGRAM

Kyabram District Health Service (KDHS) is committed to supporting secondary school students to pursue a career in the health care industry by offering work experience for local secondary school students (aged 15 or above) in 2020.

One week of placements for 8 students will be offered to successful applicants – with priority given to local Kyabram secondary schools. Indigenous, culturally diverse, and students from surrounding towns with a passion for health are encouraged to apply.

Work Experience Program:

The KDHS Work Experience Program offers local secondary school students the opportunity to experience various careers within the hospital setting.

These include:

- *Nursing/Medicine*: which may include Theatre, Community Nursing, Aged Care, General Ward and Nursing administration
- *Allied Health Stream*: which may include Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Dietetics and Social Support/Lifestyle
- *Support Services Stream*: which may include Kitchen, Café, Laundry, Cleaning, Patient Services Assistant and Social Support/Lifestyle
- *Business Administration Stream*: which may include Human Resources, Occupational Health and Safety, Client Services, Medical Records and Finance

Work Experience will **ONLY** be available in the following weeks:

- **June 29th – July 3rd 2020**
- **August 10th – 14th 2020**
- **September 14th – 18th 2020**

HOW TO APPLY

Applications will open online in March 2020, all applicants will need to apply online.

Applications must include a resume and covering letter which clearly states:

- The secondary school you attend & the Work Experience Coordinator details
- The area/stream you wish to apply for with preferred dates
- The reason you would like to do work experience at Kyabram District Health Service

KDHS in consultation with each school will review the applications and select the 8 students who will be offered positions during the allocated week.
