### Increase in KDHS Podiatry Clinics

Kyabram District Health Service (KDHS) is excited to announce further Podiatry Service for the Kyabram and district community. These clinics will commence on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> of October and will be held each fortnight. This is in addition to those offered by Bendigo Health at KDHS.

Podiatrists are trained to treat abnormal conditions of the feet and lower limbs. They can also reduce day-to-day foot problems, including toenail issues, corns and callouses.

Public podiatry services are available to people who work, or live in the Kyabram and district area. We prioritise our services for people on low-medium incomes and holders of concession cards. Services are available for those under 65 with moderate or severe disabilities. Private appointments are also available.

We offer low cost services to many clients. Fees are based on income and eligibility.

Self-referral or referral by your GP is accepted.
