Aim of Graduate Nurse Program

The Aim of the Graduate Nurse program is to facilitate the transition from student to that of a confident and competent Registered Nurse, so that the Graduate Nurse can develop and maintain an effective role in the delivery of care. This outcome is achieved with support provided by the Graduate Nurse Educators, preceptors, Nurse Unit Managers, Study Days and structured feedback.

The Program Duration is 52 weeks.

Program Commencement: **31st January 2022**

Program Content

- Comprehensive Orientation Program for the first week
- 8 Paid Study Leave Days
- Supernumerary allocation at the commencement of each Clinical Rotation
- Completion of a Clinical Project of special interest by the 10th month of the Program
- Formal Training in ALS & IV Cannulation
- Eligibility for up to 6 weeks Annual Leave – pre allocated during the program but subject to negotiation
- Clinical Supervision provided by Educators, Preceptors and Senior Staff

Rotations

Rotations are conducted within the following Clinical Areas:

- Acute Care, including Urgent Care
- Aged Care, incorporating Nursing Fundamentals and Leadership
- Perioperative Services including Day Procedure Unit
- Oncology, Renal Dialysis and District Nursing combined rotation
- COVID Vaccination Clinic experience
